- L.J.Pasteur and J.Lister completed their tests on sterilisation and pasteurisation with a few years difference.
- The 1st packaged soap and the 1st shampoo manufactured in the UK.
- The Hungarian doctor, I. Semmelweis, was the pioneer who proposed the hand washing with a solution of chlorinated lime, as a measure of preventing childbed fever.
- L.J.Pasteur patented the process of pasteurisation in 1865, 3 years after he completed the tests.
- Lever Brothers built a port in 1888, with the same name as their product, only four years after their product launched and flooded the markets worldwide.
- J.Lister applied a piece of lint dipped in carbolic acid solution onto the wound of a seven-year-old boy at Glasgow Royal Infirmary, however he published the results 2 years later.
- S.M.Muhammad lead to the creation of his product, in 1814, when he founded a business with baths at Brighton, UK.
- I. Semmelweis developed his theory while working in Vienna General Hospital's First Obstetrical Clinic and he has every right to be described as the "saviour of mothers".
- The Sunlight was invented for washing clothes and general household use. Its formula contained glycerin and vegetable oils rather than tallow (animal fats).
